STEP ONE:

Visit VA Career View at this link: <u>http://www.vaview.vt.edu/k5/check-it/kids-search/</u> You should see this page:



STEP TWO: Choose either <u>Subjects</u> or <u>Interests</u>.

Choose Subjects if you want to learn more about careers that relate to the subjects you are studying in school. Choose Interests if you want to learn about careers that relate to things you enjoy doing.



STEP THREE:

Start selecting activities or subjects that you find interesting or fun! You can choose as many as you want! Be honest with yourself and really think about each option – you will get better career matches if you go slow and are thoughtful about your choices. You should see:



STEP FOUR:

After selecting all the boxes that you want - click Next!
